Dear Parents / Carers,

Last year we consulted on school trips and took the decision to ask parents for a set £10 per child this academic year to contribute towards trips, visitors and enrichment activities. As a reminder, school will be match funding this amount and as we are trialling this year, we will be guaranteeing the trips shown. To clarify, all the trips shown below are booked and will definitely be happening. The **£10 Annual voluntary trip contribution** for enrichment has now been set up on ParentPay. You can either pay it as a one-off amount or chip away at it as the year goes on. Obviously, at the end of the academic year, we will have to assess the strategy to see how much the school has had to subsidise so our hope is that you support this strategy and pay the contribution so we can continue to provide an enriched experience to support our curriculum.

This gives you 100% visibility as to where the contribution is going and what the money is being spent on.
