



Dear parents/carers,

As we come to the end of the academic year, we would like to do something to allow children and teachers to say goodbye to their classes. It has been a long time without school for some of our families and we would like to bring classes together for a socially distanced picnic on our school field.

During the picnic, children will receive all their work books to take home along with a personal report from their class teacher. The report will also tell parents which class their child will be in next academic year. If parents would like to talk to their class teacher about their end of year report, there will be an opportunity at the end of the picnic. Alternatively, there will be a report slip for you to write a comment on and hand back in before the end of the academic year.

We also ask that if you have any school property such as reading books, resources etc. that you please bring these on the day to be returned.

To ensure that the picnic is in line with current guidelines, the following measures will be in place:

- We will be using the Hospital Street entrance to access the school field only. Children who are already in school will be taken to the field by their teacher.
- All parents and children entering the field must social distance from other families. **Only one parent can drop off and pick up please.**
- **Children will need to provide their own blanket or towel to sit on.** This will be spaced 2m apart from any other child.
- **Children will be asked to bring their own picnic lunch with them.**
- Outdoor handwashing stations will available for children to use.
- Children will not be permitted to enter the school building at any time. This means children will be unable to visit any of the school toilets.
