

CURRICULUM INTENT: MFL

<p>Intent: WHY TEACH MFL?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exposure to Foreign language will allow children to experience different cultures and appreciate the diversity of our country. • Pupils will be able to express their ideas and thoughts in another language and understand and respond to its speakers, both in speech and in writing. • Language teaching will provide the foundation for learning further languages, equipping pupils to study and work in other countries. • It will also provide opportunities for them to communicate for practical purposes.
<p>Implementation: THE MOORGATE APPROACH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Moorgate uses MFL as part of the PPA package that is taught in the afternoons by a full time PPA teacher as well as LSA's and HLTA's. • When medium term planning, Mrs Trevelyan will follow the Euro Stars programme to ensure that all year groups follow the correct progression of language skills throughout their time at the Academy. • Each lesson will be taught every two weeks in each year group. • Key Stage Two will follow the Euro Stars schemes of work which includes activity sheets and online resources. This also helps to support non-specialist teachers with their subject knowledge. • Key Stage One lessons will focus primarily on vocabulary through practical activities such as songs and games to ensure that they are ready for the skills that they will learn in Key Stage Two. • Any written work recorded for languages will be kept in a dedicated folder for each child which they will use throughout school.
<p>Impact HOW IS IT MEASURED?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At the end of each Topic, children will complete activities on the online Euro Stars resource to assess what they have learnt in the Topic. • The MFL leader will conduct termly learning walks and pupil interviews to measure the impact of the teaching of MFL.
