

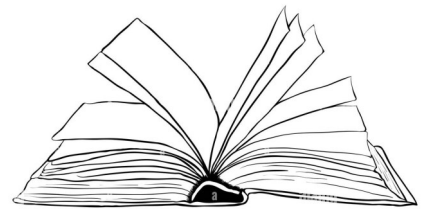
# Year 1 / 2 Newsletter

So far this term, we have been completing lots of learning in our new topics. Here are some additional ideas for extra learning at home!

At Moorgate, we promote the 50 things to do before you leave year 6. This term, we challenge you to **write your own story and read it to an audience**. You could bring in a recording of you doing this or offer to read your work to your class!



We can't stress enough how important reading is. So we ask that **20 minutes** of reading is happening **3 times per week** as a minimum.

The more the better!

Please ensure your child's home reading book and record is in school every **Monday** morning with a record of their home reading.

## Homework

Every Monday, we will be sending your child home with Phonics/Spelling and Maths homework within their homework files. This homework will be based on learning that your child has completed the previous week. It will need to be returned the following Monday.

# PE

This year we are going back to two P.E lessons per week (see timetable below).

We ask that children are sent with the appropriate kit to wear, including trainers for outdoor P.E, especially now it is getting colder. In addition, children with long hair need to bring a bobble to have this tied up and any ear rings need to be taken out. If they can not, plasters will need to be worn.
