Welcome to my Classroom



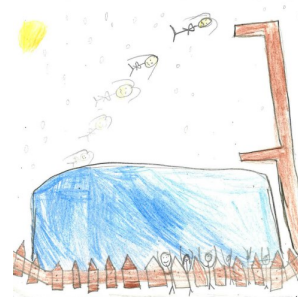
Families are invited into school at 3:30pm on Wednesday 11th September for a 'Welcome to my classroom' session with your child's new class teacher.
